Milinda Moragoda, Director/CEO K. Balasunderam, Director Bernard Goonetilleke, and Director J. Moragoda were present on this occasion.

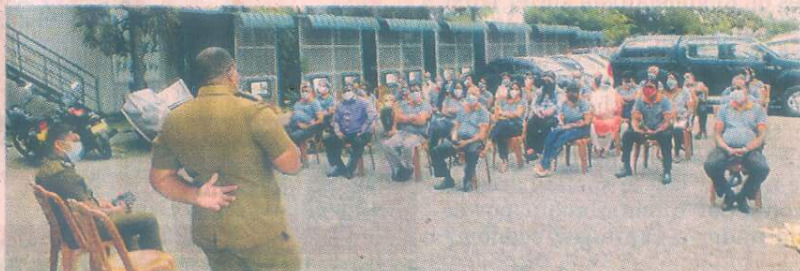
